

The cream of the crop meets in Bursa

Only 5 days left until the **Sukay World Trophy 2009** begins. From 02. - 04. october at one of europe's most beautiful cableparks in Bursa it will be determined who will lead the world ranking 2009.

Stars like Mike Ketellapper (NL), Nick Davies (GB) and Lior Sofer (ISR) will meet the best riders from overseas. Tom Fooshee and Keith Lidberg, both from the USA won't have any chances to get a top placement in the ranking because they did not ride enough competitions of this year's tour, but they definitely will fight to win the Sukay Park World Trophy with its enormous cash prize of 50.000 US Dollar.

4 categories will fight for the total prize money of more than **100.000 US Dollar**. This is the biggest cashprize in cablewakeboard history. The prize money is announced by the municipality of Bursa Osmangazi who are also the operators of the Sukay Park.

Besides the Junior Men and Junior Ladies from 16 - 18 years the cream of the crop of cablewakeboarding will start in the Open Men and Ladies. The extraordinary athlete Maxine Sapulette is the only one whose win is almost certain. But as we've seen during the European Championships in Ukkohalla also Maxine nerves can be on the edge. High pressure will last on every rider's shoulders which will guarantee for some surprises and lots of tension during this season's highlight.
